REVISED NOTICE OF APPLICABILITY, RE-ENROLLMENT OF CITY OF MORRO BAY IN WATER QUALITY ORDER 2012-0010, GENERAL WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS FOR AQUIFER STORAGE AND RECOVERY PROJECTS THAT INJECT DRINKING WATER INTO GROUNDWATER, AND TRANSMITTAL OF REVISED MONITORING AND REPORTING PROGRAM NO. R3-2021-0067

On August 6, 2024, the Central Coast Regional Water Quality Control Board (Central Coast Water Board) received comments from the City of Morro Bay on the City's revised notice of applicability for Order 2012-0010 issued on July 11, 2024. We understand that the City of Morro Bay will utilize a blend of groundwater and treated surface water (State Water Project) water as the injectate for this revised pilot study as presented in the June 18, 2024 Tracer Test Workplan. The groundwater will be extracted from the Lower Morro Valley Groundwater Basin.
