What is the “WRF” Project?

- Replaces the City’s existing wastewater treatment plant with an advanced water purification facility
 - Meets state regulations
 - Protects the environment
 - Contributes a safe and reliable water source for Morro Bay’s homes and businesses
- Creates a drought buffer capable of providing up to 80 percent of the City’s water needs in the future



Program Update: WRF Pipelines Progress

- Utility verification
- Tree removal
- Sewer bypass pipeline installation (near roundabout)
- Lift Station site (Embarcadero)
- Lift Station site (Near Main Street and Quintana Road)



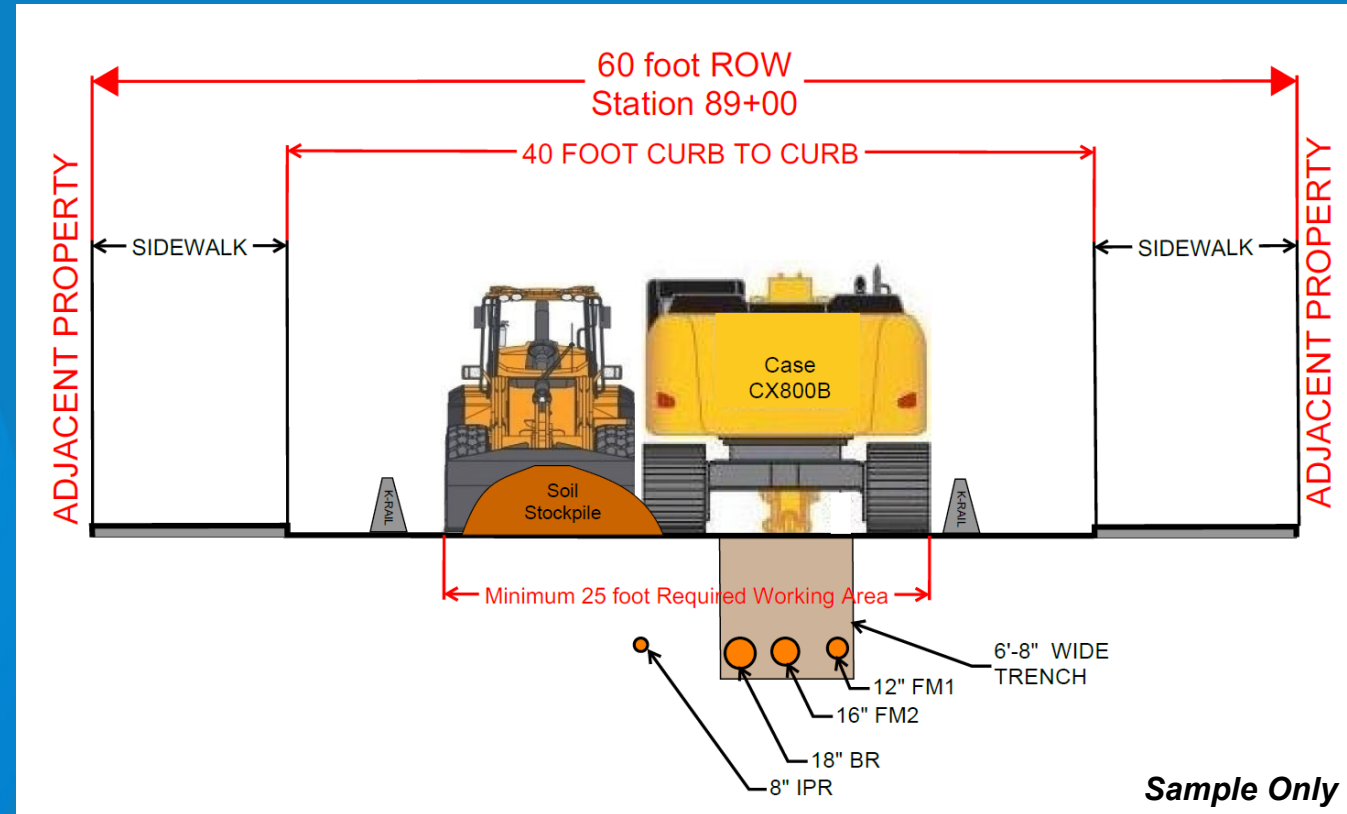
Construction Look-ahead: April 2021

- Pipeline construction crew #1:
Quintana Road between La Loma
and South Bay Boulevard
 - Detour is Highway 1
- Pipeline construction crew #2:
Main Street between Highway 1
and Quintana Road
 - Two-way traffic from Highway 1
to Quintana Road



What To Expect: Construction

- Work from Monday to Friday, 7 a.m. to 3:30 p.m.
- Excavation, installation of four pipelines, backfilling, offhauling and road restoration
- Moving work zones between cross-streets to direct through-traffic
- Emergency, business and residential access maintained

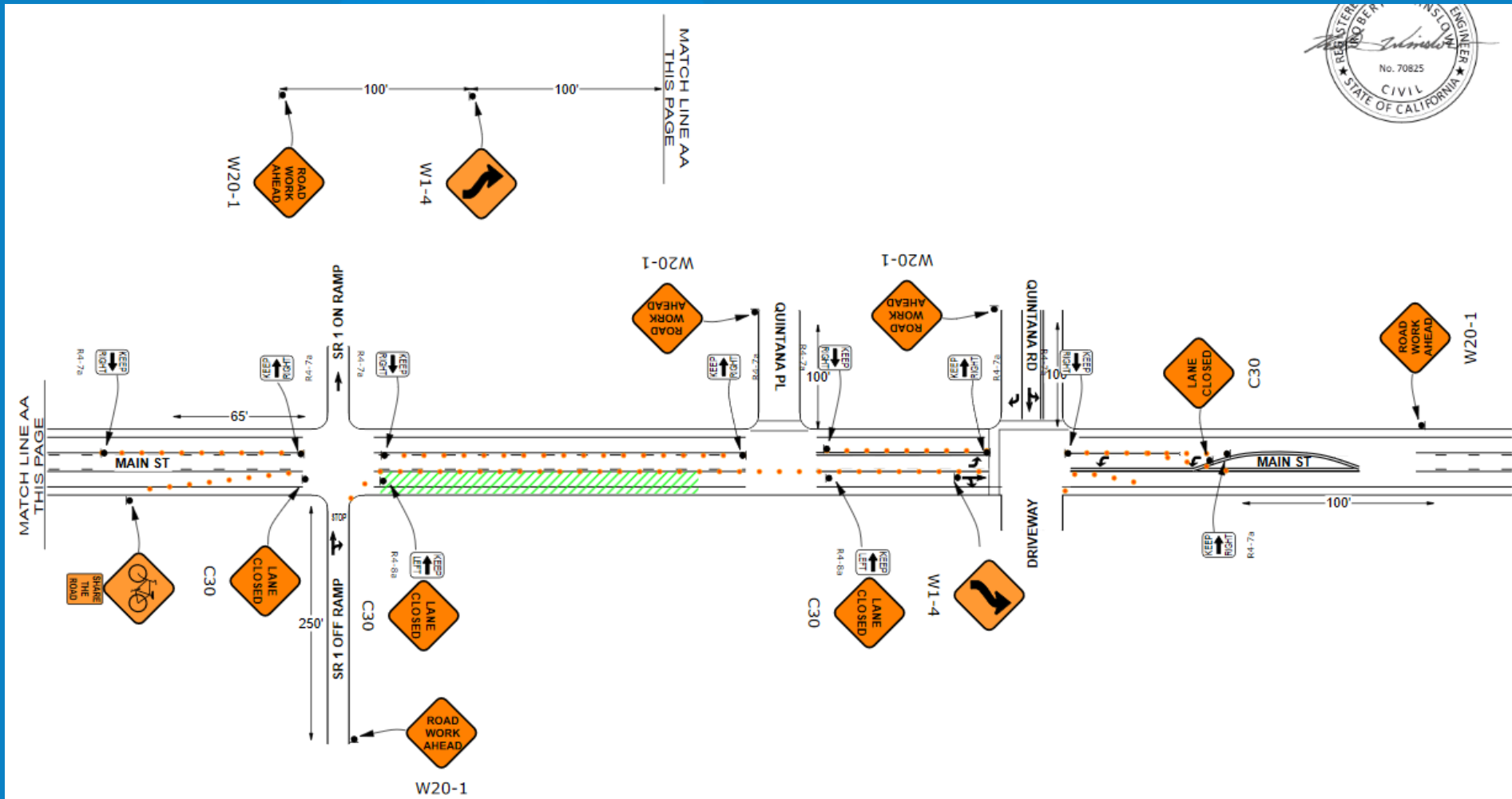

Main Street to the Roundabout

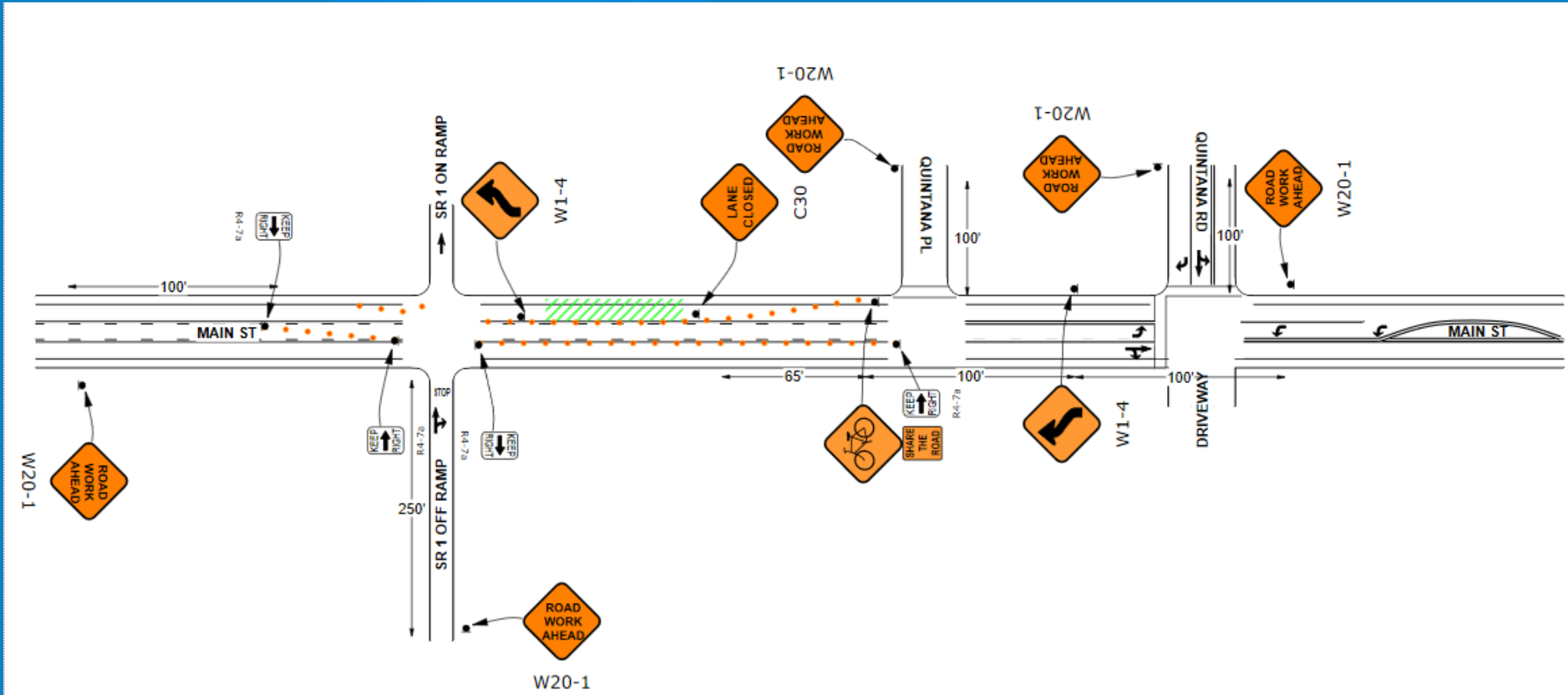
- Business access maintained

Main Street (Highway 1 to Quintana Place)



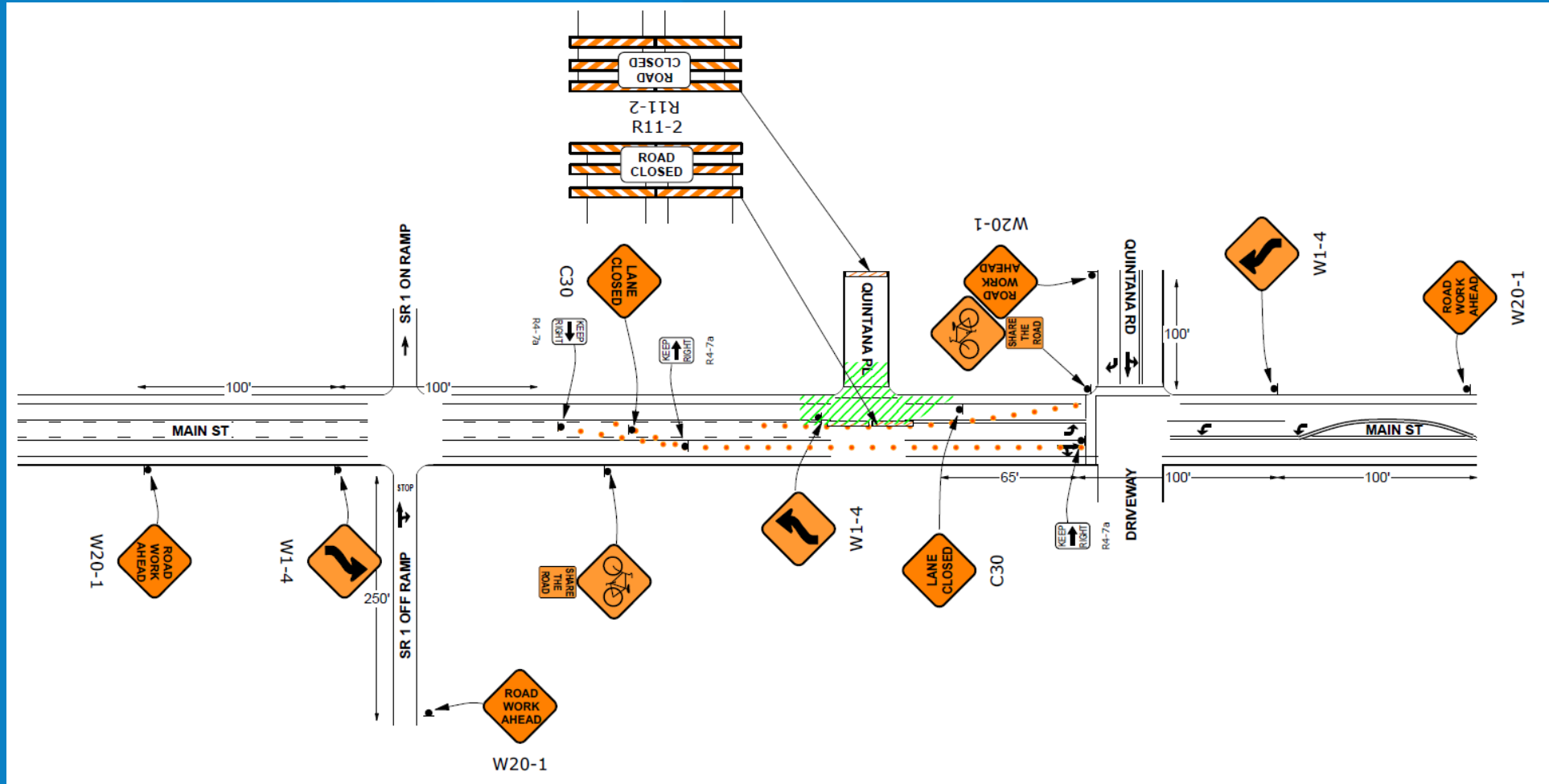
- Two-way traffic
