### CONSTRUCTION NOTICE: Quintana Road Closed at Kennedy Way

June 22, 2021

From Wednesday, June 23, to Friday, July 2, Quintana Road will be closed between 420 Quintana Road and Kennedy Way as part of the City of Morro Bay Water Reclamation Facility (WRF) Pipelines and Lift Stations project.

**What To Expect:** Construction crews must relocate a water main through the intersection of Quintana Road and Kennedy Way, in addition to constructing pipelines on Quintana Road. The posted detours for this road closure are Main Street and Morro Bay Boulevard. Kennedy Way will be open to local business traffic and through traffic will be detoured at Shasta Avenue. After the pipelines are installed on Quintana Road across Kennedy Way, Quintana Road will be open to southbound traffic only. All businesses will remain open and accessible. Please follow all posted signage and crew member directions near the work zone and expect delays in the area.

**When:** The contractor will be working in and around the intersection of Quintana Road and Kennedy Way until July 2, 2021. Work is generally scheduled Monday to Friday from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m., except Wednesday, June 23, when evening work is scheduled until 10 p.m.

**Why:** The City of Morro Bay is investing in the construction of the WRF Program that will protect our environment, and provide a safe, clean and reliable water supply for our community, both current and future generations. The WRF Program involves replacing the City's existing wastewater treatment plant with an advanced water purification facility that will meet state regulations, protect the environment, and contribute a safe and reliable water source for Morro Bay's homes and businesses. The project will create a drought buffer and will be capable of providing up to 80 percent of the City's water needs in the future.

The City is committed to clear communication and providing up-to-date information about construction activities. Properties along the construction area will receive printed notices before work begins near their address, and construction notices will be regularly posted on [morrobaywrf.com](http://morrobaywrf.com).
