CONSTRUCTION NOTICE: PAVING WORK SCHEDULED ON QUINTANA ROAD BETWEEN KENNEDY WAY AND MORRO BAY BOULEVARD

Sept. 16, 2021

What To Expect: Paving work is scheduled to occur on or after September 23 on Quintana Road from

Kennedy Way to Morro Bay Boulevard as part of the City of Morro Bay Water

Reclamation Facility (WRF) Pipelines. After the paving, which will create a temporary drivable surface, Quintana Road will be opened to two-way traffic between Kennedy Way and Morro Bay Boulevard until construction crews return later to construct the smaller, single purified water pipeline and complete final paving. When schedule information is available for the purified water pipeline construction and final paving,

notifications will be distributed to neighboring properties.

When: Construction is scheduled on weekdays from 7 a.m. to 5:30 p.m. Weekend or night

work may be scheduled, as needed, but neighboring properties will be informed in

advance of schedule changes.

Why: The WRF Program is the largest-ever City infrastructure program, and will meet state

water and wastewater regulations, protect the environment and contribute a safe and reliable water source for Morro Bay's residents and businesses. The WRF Program involves replacing the City's existing wastewater treatment plant with an advanced water purification facility that will create a drought buffer and will be capable of providing up to 80 percent of the City's water needs in the future.

The City is committed to clear communication and providing up-to-date information about construction activities. Construction notices will be regularly posted on morrobaywrf.com.
