CONSTRUCTION NOTICE: CONSTRUCTION SCHEDULED ON WATER RECLAMATION FACILITY PIPELINES ON SOUTH BAY BOULEVARD

Sept. 6, 2022

As part of the City of Morro Bay Water Reclamation Facility (WRF) Pipelines project, pipeline connection work is scheduled on South Bay Boulevard between Quintana Road and Teresa Drive overnight on **Thursday, Sept. 8.**

What To Expect: During this connection work, there will be a temporary water shutdown for properties on Teresa Drive.

Traffic control will be in place on South Bay Boulevard, between Quintana Road and Teresa Drive. South Bay Boulevard, including access to and from Highway 1, will remain open with alternating one-way traffic controlled by flaggers. Please plan extra time to accommodate for potential delays near Highway 1, and please follow posted signage. Access will be maintained for emergency responders.

When: Construction on South Bay Boulevard is scheduled on Thursday, Sept. 8, from 8 p.m. to 7 a.m. Water service will be temporarily shut down starting at 8 p.m. and will be restored as soon as possible, and no later than 7 a.m. on Friday, Sept. 9.
