ACCESS RESTORED ON SOUTH BAY BOULEVARD AT HIGHWAY 1

April 28, 2022

After four months of pipeline construction on South Bay Boulevard as part of the City of Morro Bay Water Reclamation Facility (WRF) Pipelines, **South Bay Boulevard at Highway 1 will be reopened by the end of the day on Friday, April 29.** The WRF Program is the largest-ever City infrastructure program, and will meet state water and wastewater regulations, protect the environment, and contribute a safe and reliable water source for Morro Bay's residents and businesses.

Access to and from Highway 1 at South Bay Boulevard will be restored, and paving on South Bay Boulevard will be completed when the road is reopened on Friday, April 29. Over the last four months, crews installed four pipelines on South Bay Boulevard to connect to the new WRF on South Bay Boulevard, critical component as construction of the WRF nears completion.

Thank you to the communities of Morro Bay and Los Osos, and users of South Bay Boulevard, for demonstrating patience and cooperation during this extended road closure!
