PAVING WORK SCHEDULED FOR MORRO BAY WATER RECLAMATION FACILITY PIPELINES

Jan. 31, 2023

What To Expect: Weather permitting, paving and striping work is scheduled to occur in the following phased areas through Friday, Feb. 10, as part of the City of Morro Bay Water Reclamation Facility (WRF) Pipelines:

Quintana Road from Morro Bay Boulevard to Main Street: Pavement grinding is scheduled on Thursday, Feb. 2, and Friday, Feb. 3. A partial road closure will be in effect with northbound traffic open from Morro Bay Boulevard through Main Street, and southbound traffic detoured via Main Street and Morro Bay Boulevard.

Main Street between Quintana Road and the Bike Path: Pavement grinding, installation and striping are scheduled on Monday, Feb. 6, with flaggers directing traffic on Main Street.

Quintana Road between La Loma and Las Tunas: Paving installation and striping are scheduled on Tuesday, Feb. 7, with flaggers directing traffic.

Quintana Road from Morro Bay Boulevard to Main Street: Pavement installation and striping are scheduled from Wednesday, Feb. 8, to Friday, Feb. 10. A partial road closure will be in effect with northbound traffic on Quintana Road accessible from Morro Bay Boulevard through Main Street, and southbound traffic detoured via Main Street and Morro Bay Boulevard.

Please follow all posted signage and construction crew member directions, and please plan extra time when traveling on Quintana Road and Main Street. Traffic control will be set up and moved with the paving equipment.

When: Paving and striping work is currently scheduled from 7 a.m. to 5:30 p.m. Paving will be scheduled in February 2023 on Atascadero Road.
