FAST FACTS to help you answer questions from customers

About the Project: The City of Morro Bay Water Reclamation Facility (WRF) Program will replace the City's existing wastewater treatment plant with an advanced water purification facility that will meet state regulations, protect the environment, and contribute a safe and reliable water source for Morro Bay's homes and businesses. The project will create a drought buffer and is capable of providing up to 80 percent of the City's water needs in the future.

Construction is underway on the WRF Pipelines and Lift Stations, including four pipelines. The pipelines will be constructed in segments on Atascadero Road, Main Street, Quintana Road and South Bay Boulevard, on weekdays from 7 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. each day. Construction will be completed in segments within the public right-of-way, to limit public impacts at any given time and to allow for access between cross-streets. Lane closures and, when needed, detours will be in place for traffic circulation and access. Construction is expected to be complete by the end of 2021.

The City's Commitment: The City is committed to maintaining business, residential and emergency vehicle access to properties throughout construction.
