# What is the "WRF" Project?


- Replaces the City's existing wastewater treatment plant with an advanced water purification facility
  - Meets state regulations
  - Protects the environment
  - Contributes a safe and reliable water source for Morro Bay's homes and businesses
- Creates a drought buffer capable of providing up to 80 percent of the City's water needs in the future





# Program Update: WRF Pipelines Progress

- Utility verification (ongoing)
- Lift station site (Embarcadero)
- Lift station site (Near Main Street and Quintana Road)
- Trenching and pipe installation (Quintana Road near Main Street)
- Gas line relocation by SoCal Gas (Near Las Tunas and Quintana Road)
- Water bypass line installed (Near La Loma and Quintana Road)
- Trenching and pipe installation (La Loma to South Bay Boulevard)





## Construction Look-ahead: June 2021

- Pipeline construction crew #1: Quintana Road between La Loma and South Bay Boulevard
  - Detour is Highway 1
- Pipeline construction crew #2: Quintana
  Road moving southeast to Kennedy Way
  - Northbound detour is Kennedy Way to Dunes Street and Main Street
- Water line relocation: Quintana Road across Kennedy Way
- Tunneling preparation: Las Tunas Street





## Quintana Road and Kennedy Way

- Nighttime construction 7 p.m. to midnight
- Road open during daytime
- Construction at Kennedy Way/Quintana Road intersection done in two phases (half at a time)
- Northbound traffic open on Quintana Road
- Southbound traffic on Quintana Road detoured via Main Street and Dunes Street
- Access coordinated for businesses and emergency services

### **Las Tunas Street**

- Las Tunas Street near Quintana Road closed through the summer
- Upcoming work including pile driving, shoring and excavation
- Tunneling under Morro Bay Boulevard roundabout to start at end of June
- Access coordinated for residents, businesses and emergency services
