Since 2013, the City has prepared numerous environmental studies and conducted extensive public outreach to find the best location for the new Water Reclamation Facility (WRF). **On June 14, 2016, the City Council selected the South Bay Boulevard (formerly “Tri-W”) site for further detailed planning efforts leading to construction of a new facility.**

The City is now beginning the formal environmental review process for this site. Under the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), the first step is to distribute a

Notice of Preparation (NOP) that an Environmental Impact Report (EIR) will be prepared to address the potential impacts of the project. **This will be the opportunity to let the environmental team know what is important or not important to you.** The City will use this information to refine the scope of the EIR analysis, leading to the preparation of a public Draft EIR.
