## What is the "WRF" Project?

- Replaces the City's existing wastewater treatment plant with an advanced water purification facility
  - Meets state regulations
  - Protects the environment
  - Contributes a safe and reliable water source for Morro Bay's homes and businesses
- Creates a drought buffer capable of providing up to 80 percent of the City's water needs in the future





## Program Update: WRF Pipelines Progress

# Pre-construction began in early February 2021

- Utility verification
- Tree removal
- Sewer bypass pipeline installation
- Pipeline construction (Quintana Road between La Loma and South Bay Boulevard)
- Lift Station site (Embarcadero)
- Lift Station site (Near Main Street and Quintana Road)











