# ATTENTION: UNPLANNED FULL ROAD CLOSURE ON QUINTANA ROAD

## What To Expect:

Out of an abundance of caution for public safety considerations, a portion of Quintana Road must be fully closed starting June 15 for up to two weeks. The City of Morro Bay Water Reclamation Facility (WRF) Pipelines project contractor has experienced unstable trenching conditions between 420 Quintana Road and Kennedy Way, making it unsafe to leave this stretch of Quintana Road open to vehicles. This road closure was not planned, and additional notices will be distributed as soon as more defined schedule information is available.

All businesses in the area will be accessible via Main Street or Kennedy Way. Please follow all posted signage and construction crew member directions.

### When:

Quintana Road, from 420 Quintana Road to Kennedy Way, will be closed starting June 15 for up to two weeks. Construction is scheduled on weekdays from 7 a.m. to 5:30 p.m.
