**WATER RECLAMATION FACILITY PROJECT
CONSTRUCTION NOTICE**

- What:** The City of Morro Bay is required by the San Luis Obispo County Air Pollution Control District (SLOAPCD) to notify nearby residents that the Water Reclamation Facility project site contains naturally occurring asbestos (NOA) in rock form, that will be excavated periodically over the next 3 months. A NOA Dust Mitigation Plan has been approved by SLOAPCD and will be implemented and overseen by a qualified and designated Competent Person. The NOA Dust Mitigation Plan is intended to eliminate potential risk to project staff and nearby residents by controlling and containing dust by keeping the material moist during excavation.
- Warning:** Soils in this area may contain naturally-occurring asbestos. Asbestos is a known carcinogen. Report excessive fugitive dust to the project hotline at 877-MORROBAYH2O or SLOAPCD at 805-781-5912.

The Water Reclamation Facility Program involves replacing the City's existing wastewater treatment plant with an advanced water purification facility that will meet state regulations, protect the environment, and contribute a safe and reliable water source for Morro Bay's homes and businesses. The project will create a drought buffer and will be capable of providing up to 80 percent of the City's water needs in the future.
